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NSPS Subpart Dc Semi-Annual Report Form for Fuel Oil-Fired Boilers

Boilers which are manufactured after June 9, 1989 with a maximum heat input greater than 10 MMBtu/hr are subject to *Standards of Performance for Small Industrial-Commercial-Institutional Steam Generating Units*, 40 C.F.R. Part 60, Subpart Dc (Subpart Dc).

Boilers which are subject to Subpart Dc and which fire oil are required to submit semi-annual reports to EPA and Maine DEP. The attached form, along with copies of fuel supplier certifications, may be used to fulfill this reporting requirement. Reports must be postmarked by the 30th day following the end of the reporting period.

This form is only applicable to oil-fired boilers with a heat input less than 30 MMBtu/hr. Larger boilers are subject to opacity limits and additional reporting requirements.

Instructions:

1. Fill in the information indicated on the form.
2. The form must be signed by the facility owner or operator.
3. Attach copies of all fuel supplier certifications for the reporting period.
4. Mail the form and supplier certifications to the EPA address shown.
5. Mail a copy of the form and certifications to the DEP Regional office associated with your facility. Addresses are provided below.
