



The Draft Board Order satisfactorily addresses the issues and concerns raised by the City in this proceeding and described in the Pre-Filed Testimony of City Manager William J. Mayo and of CES, Inc. President Denis St. Peter, P.E., which include: 1) Use of and payment for Construction and Demolition Debris (CDD) Fines used as Alternative Daily Cover; 2) Use of and payment for Soft Layer Waste; 3) Road and traffic impacts; 4) City's role under Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions; 5) General compliance with solid waste statutes and regulations; and 6) Odor and public health.
