

**Certification of Scrap as Meeting EPA Standards for Acceptance by  
Electric Arc Furnaces and Iron and Steel Foundries**

Federal law requires that electric arc furnaces and iron or steel foundries have assurance from each of their auto scrap providers that the motor vehicle scrap provider has removed the following from all vehicles before crushing: all free liquids, including used oil filters; parts made of lead, including lead wheel weights; parts made of PVC plastic (vinyl); and all mercury switches. To meet this law, you can provide a copy of this certification to the buyer of your scrap.

**I certify under penalty of law that my facility has removed the following from motor vehicles prior to crushing and/or selling:**

**I also certify that my facility takes part in Maine's Mercury Vehicle Switch Removal Program (Maine DEP has identified this as an EPA-approved program for the removal of mercury switches).**

**It is my understanding that the company to which I am selling these vehicles will remove the parts made of PVC plastic (vinyl).**
