Underground Oil Storage Tank Facility Class "C" Operator Training Checklist

All Maine retail and motor fuel underground oil storage tank (UST) facilities must have a certified Class "C" Operator on-site at all times during normal business hours. Class C Operators, at a minimum, must be trained on the facility specific items below by a Maine Certified Class A/B Operator. This form will be used to certify the training provided to a Class C Operator. This form must be kept at the facility and made available to the Department of Environmental Protection upon request.

Check each area of training upon completion

- UST Facility Components, Functions and Daily Procedures
- Fuel Dispensing Emergency Shut-off(s): Location(s) and Usage
- Leak Detection Console (if applicable): Warnings, Alarms and Response
- Evidence of a Possible Leak: Response and Emergency Contacts

- Spills & Overfills: Prevention and Procedures/Actions
- Spill logs: Location and Procedures
- Speedi-Dri and Oil Absorbent Pads: Location, Use and Disposal.
- Fires and Other Emergencies: Procedures/Actions & Notifications
